The Aiken Golf Club championship is scheduled for October 23rd, 24th and 25th. All Cedar Creek member women and men are eligible to participate. The women's championship will be a one-day event on Friday, the 23rd, with tee times beginning at 9:30. Entry is \$33 with cart or \$18 if walking or on cart plan. The men's championship will be contested on Saturday and Sunday with three divisions: Open (any age) playing from the medal tees, Senior (55 & over) playing from the mid tees, and Super Senior (70 & over) at the fore tees. Tee times for the Senior and Super Senior divisions begin at 8:30 both days. Open division tee times will begin at 10:30 on Saturday and 11:00 on Sunday. Entry is \$57 for all men's divisions or \$25 if walking both days or on cart plan. Net prizes in addition to gross will be awarded in the women's and all men's divisions proportionate to the number of entries. (A current USGA handicap index is required to be eligible for net prizes.) Registration is open now at the AGC shop. Deadline for signup is Tuesday, October 20th.


The Cedar Creek club championship will follow on November 21st and 22nd. Details will be forthcoming.
