

CCGA Meeting Minutes 1/18/94

- Meeting called to order in CC Grill Room at 7:25 PM by President Glen Moseley. Nine members were present (see attached roster).
- Treasurer's report given by Johnny Maloney.

\$712.00 balance not including a \$5.00 rebate to Don Thomas.
We have 26 new members (excluding Don Thomas).

Treasurer's report accepted.

- Previous meeting minutes read by Tom Welch and accepted.

Tom is to make a Volume 1 from his minutes.

Alan Gregory suggested putting minutes into a hard binder.

Tom Welch suggested having a volume for each year.

Glen Moseley suggested including a picture of the committee for the year in the volume.

- Glen Moseley recommended that Stan Black meet with Ray Mundy to establish tournament dates. Glen recommended one tournament per quarter. Glen said that he would like to raffle his set of Cleveland Classic golf clubs and donate a portion of the money toward the purchase of the large layout sign to be placed adjacent to the putting green.
- Ray Mundy stated that he would handle the Club Championship Tournament. He suggested that he sponsor four tournaments (Club Championship, a scramble, member/guest, and one other). Ray suggests CCGA sponsor two tournaments and any others together with the club. Ray stated that the Club Championship Tournament must be a stroke-play event.
- Glen Moseley suggested having a Calcutta before each tournament. Different tournament formats were discussed to arouse interest including the possibility of having Friday night functions, etc.

Ray suggested Friday practice rounds, optional derbies, Calcuttas, golf Saturday and dinner for members and guests.

- Ray wants the CCGA to handle the December tournament.
- Glen suggested that CCGA handle the December tournament and a tournament on March 5, 1994. Ray will recommend a format.
- A recommendation was made to have a Member/Guest tournament on Friday, April 29, 1994 with a Bar-B-Que that afternoon with golf Saturday with hor d'ouvres following. This would be a two-man best ball format. Ray will sponsor this tournament.
- The Vice-President passed with no comments.
- The Tournament Director passed with no comments.
- Alan Gregory presented the South Carolina Golf Guide as information for golf trips.
- J.D. Wiggins suggested that the dog fight rules not allow ball movement in the rough.
- Glen mentioned that we cannot use the dog fight rules as they exist to post official scores.
- Ray Mundy stated that if you are not playing by the rules of golf, you should not post your scores. He said that if you were abiding by the rules;however, you should post scores.
- Chuck Wienke suggested that we post a photograph of Ray and his assistants in the Pro Shop. Ray said that he knew a photographer who could do it. Todd Lista's name was mentioned. Johnny Maloney made a motion to have photographs framed and hung in Pro Shop. The motion was carried. Glen asked Johnny to investigate prices, etc. and return information by the February meeting. This was brought in the form of a motion which was carried by the members.

- Alan Gregory moved to have the first and second year committees photographs made. This motion was also seconded and passed by the members.
- J.D. Wiggins asked Glen Moseley to investigate the Tri-State Golf Association membership requirements. He said that the head pro at Midland Valley could give information on it. Johnny Maloney moved that CCGA pursue this issue. The motion was seconded and passed.
- Glen Moseley suggested that we have another inter-corporation tournament and Ray Mundy should host it.
- The CCGA unanimously agreed that any tournament we host should be done professionally.
- The CCGA officially offered thanks to Ray Mundy for sponsoring a rules information session before the regularly scheduled CCGA meeting.
- Charlie Smith moved to adjourn the January CCGA meeting at 9:05PM. The motion was seconded and passed by the members.]

CCGA Meeting Minutes 2/15/94

- The meeting was called to order in the CC Grill Room at 6:15 PM by CCGA President Glen Moseley. Ten members and one guest were present (see attached roster).
- Glen Moseley asked Johnny Molony to give the Treasurer's report; however, Johnny officially passed the duty to Earl Beckam who was present at this meeting to assume Treasurer duties.

Earl reported no change in the balance from last month. The balance remains \$712.00.

- Glen Moseley asked that the Treasurer's Report be accepted, a motion was made, seconded, and carried by the members.
