

**CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION**  
**MONTHLY MEETING**  
**January 5, 2004**

**1. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:** President, Ron Phillips, called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm and introduced the new board. Ron thanked the past board for their hard work and leadership and the current board members for their willingness to serve. He also thanked Marty Katz for his expertise in setting up and straightening out any problems with the computer. In addition, Ron thanked the club management for working with the association.

**2.** President Ron included in his introductory remarks the board's objectives for the coming year. They are, "To promote fellowship among members and to foster a desire for advancement and improvement of their golf games." He is working on better communication and encouraging members to attend the meetings. He asked the members for their cooperation in being recognized by the chair when wanting to speak on an issue, to introduce themselves and speak clearly and loudly and not interrupt other members.

**3. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** Helen Barry, Secretary, read the minutes of the December 16, 2003 minutes. There was a correction to the paragraph regarding the gift certificates that should read as follows:

"President Pecoraro presented outgoing Vice President Pat Sullivan with a gift certificate to Pier 1 for her past years' services on the board. Paul Pecoraro, President, and George Kowalczyk, Tournament Chair, were presented with gift certificates from the association and pro shop in recognition of their years' services."

The minutes were approved as corrected.

**4. STAFF REPORT:** Hank Thurmond thanked the outgoing and incoming officers for their support last year and for the coming year. He appreciated the tournament play and donations to the club. (e.g. flag pole in front of the club house). Hank mentioned that Mike Hoffstatter, Club Manager and Randy Richardson, Golf Course Superintendent, were present to answer any questions pertaining to their duties.

**5.** Mike Hoffstatter also thanked the outgoing and incoming boards. He announced that January is usually a month when not much happens. However, the monthly Sunday breakfast and Tuesday dinners will begin again on January 18 and January 27, respectively. Mike mentioned that new tee markers were in place.

**6.** Pat Sullivan asked about the condition of the cups on the greens. Randy answered that they were being painted on a rotating basis.

7. Burt Wronsky mentioned that there needed to be sand in the bottles on the carts and the ball washers flushed. Hand Thurmond replied that these items were being taken care of.

**8. TREASURER'S REPORT:** In the treasurer's absence, Ron read the Treasurer's Report. The current balance is \$1,303.55 with two outstanding bills totaling \$51.00 to be paid. A copy of the report is on file.

**9. TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS' REPORT:** Phil Stack, tournament Co-Chair, announced the "Salute to George" tournament on January 17 and encouraged participation. He also mentioned that there are cards available with the tournament dates for the coming year and encouraged members to give the chairs ideas for tournament formats.

10. Pat Sullivan brought up the issue of needing to have an established USGA handicap in order to participate in the monthly tournaments. She also suggested that there be an association tournament when a score could be posted.

There was lengthy discussion regarding the matter of having a handicap to participate in the monthly tournaments.

The following **motion** was made by Ward Welch, seconded and passed:

**"In order to play in CCGA tournaments a participant must have an established USGA handicap. Anyone without a handicap will play from scratch."**

Dean Wood made a **motion** that was seconded, **"That for each tournament the Handicap Committee rule on the sufficiency and legitimacy of all the handicaps."** The motion was passed.

**11. OLD BUSINESS:** George Patterson asked about the black tees on #6 hole being moved. Mike Hoffstatter answered that eventually it would be done but is not a priority at this time.

**12. NEW BUSINESS:** Paul Pecoraro announced that he is the representative for the CSRA Seniors. Anyone interested in joining to see him for an application form. However, there is a waiting list.



MONTHLY MEETING  
February 2, 2004**

President, Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**1.MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** Helen Barry, Secretary, read the minutes of the January 4, 2004 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:** President Ron Phillips reported that Wayne Jones had suffered a heart attack while attending a convention in Orlando. Mike Hoffstatter and Pat Sullivan had spoken to him and reported that his spirits were good, that he would be having a quadruple by-pass on Tuesday, Feb. 3, and that flowers were not usually permitted after such surgery. It was recommended that flowers or a plant be sent to him after his return home. Mike has his phone number and address. Ron also announced that Paul Pecoraro's father had passed away several weeks ago.

**2.b.** As Marty Katz was present, Ron again thanked him for his help with the computer. Ron also thanked Jerry Sullivan and Burt Wronsky for their help on the computer for the dog fights.

**2.c.** Ron announced that per our Constitution, the immediate past-president (Paul Pecoraro) is a member of the Executive Board (during 2004).

**2.d.** Ron also announced that a copy of the current Constitution and Bylaws with amendments noted are posted on the bulletin board in the Members' Lounge. A copy of the current minutes will also be posted there. He also urged members to take a look at the various plaques in the Members' Lounge!

**2.e.** Ron reported that the Handicap Committee consists of the following members:

**2.f.** We will continue to include CCGA inserts in the monthly Club billings.

**2.g.** Ron reminded attendees to: Be recognized before speaking; stand up and speak loudly and not to interrupt the speaker.

**3.TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder reported that there had been two hole-in-ones, Bob Podewils and Bill Marks. The current treasury balance is \$1,607.42.

**4.TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair, Al Bowyer, reported that there were 71 participants in the January tournament. Twenty-five (approximately 1/3 of the participants) received prizes. The co-chairs are trying to make check-in, etc. easier for the pro shop. Al encouraged participants to sign up early.

**5.a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter reported that last week's dinner was canceled due to the ice storm and was moved to February 3. He announced that February 14 would be a "Beat the Boss" tournament and that February 21 is the CCGA tournament. The Club will serve Sunday Breakfast at the Grille on February 29.

**5.b.** Mike reported that there was lots of debris on the course, but the course was open for business by Wednesday afternoon. Relief without penalty may be taken from piles of debris still on the course. Mike Wittkamp asked if volunteers could help out. (Answer: not at this time).

**5.c.** Ken Dishop asked about the schedule of cleanup for the entire course. Mike replied that playability and potential hazards would be taken care of first. President Phillips suggested that if anyone had a specific issue to talk it over with Mike or the Thurmonds.

**6.a. HANDICAP COMMITTEE REPORT:** Doug Snyder, Chair reported many members were not recording all their scores in the computer. The Committee will provide guidance regarding which scores they can record.

**6.b.** Mike Hoffstatter stated that a new handicap system software is in place in the computer. It will "hold" a 9-hole score until a second 9-hole score is recorded.

**6.c.** Doug explained how to post incomplete rounds and mulligan rounds. Ron encouraged the members to read the insert in the monthly billing that also provides guidance on the posting of scores.

**7.a. OLD BUSINESS:** Ron asked about the status of the plaque for the flagpole. Pat Sullivan responded that Wayne Jones had been working on that and it will have to wait until he is feeling better.

**7.b.** Ron mentioned that a chair had been purchased a couple of years ago in the memory of Johnny Molony but a plaque, which had also been approved, had not been obtained. Ed Griffin will look into a plaque with the inscription, "Play by the Rules – Johnny Molony".

**7.c.** Mike Hoffstatter is taking care of the plaques for the 2003 club championship.

7.d. Mimi Wittkamp asked about the hole-in-one policy. Who should receive recognition? (CCGA members). She knew of one person, Jon Groteluschen, who had had two holes-in-one but had not been recognized. The oversight will be checked out.

**8.a. NEW BUSINESS:** Ron announced that Burt Wronsky would be compiling a list of the rules and policies of the dogfights. Jerry Sullivan volunteered to help Burt.

**8.b.** Ron indicated that the Members' Lounge needs a larger bulletin board to display handicaps, notices, bylaws, minutes, etc. Ed Griffin volunteered to look into a larger bulletin board.

**8.c.** Ron also asked the members if they had any objections to moving the regular meeting to the third Monday of the month. This would enable the CCGA inserts in the pro shop billings to be more timely. The members did not voice any objections. Ron indicated he would consider the matter further and make a decision in the near future. He also requested that any member who would like to receive the minutes, notices, etc. by e-mail to give the secretary their e-mail address. Marty Katz stated that there should be a privacy policy statement in the bylaws. This will need to be investigated.

**8.d.** Ron has appointed a committee to establish and implement a financial plan for 2004 to identify projects requiring funds and identify sources of income to fund the projects. The committee consists of:

## **CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING - MARCH 1, 2004**

President, Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** Helen Barry, Secretary, read the minutes of the February 2, 2004 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:** President Ron Phillips reported that Wayne Jones was recovering from his heart surgery and thanks everyone for their cards, best wishes and prayers. Wayne hopes to be at the April meeting.

**2.b.** Ron announced that he would continue to put CCGA inserts in the monthly Club billings; members should sign in and provide their e-mail addresses if interested in receiving the minutes and notices through that medium.

**3.TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder reported that the February tournament was successful and the current balance in the treasury is \$1,926.05.

**4.TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair, Phil Stack, reported that there were 90 participants in the February tournament with 33 prizewinners. The March 20th tournament will be the Par 3 tournament.

**5.a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter announced that "clean-up" day would possibly be the end of March. He will post a date. He also announced that new golf carts would arrive around mid-March.

**5.b.** The "Beat the Boss" tournament is rescheduled for March 6; the Grille will serve dinner March 9 and breakfast on March 29<sup>th</sup>.

**5.c.** The Maintenance Staff is trying to kill weeds before the grass begins to grow. One nine will be closed next week on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and possibly Friday depending on the weather.

**5.d.** There will be a "second" round of course cleanup that will continue until everything is done. Mike Wittkamp asked if the "hanging limbs" would be cut. Mike answered, "if they can be reached."

**5.e.** Other questions and comments pertained to slow play, better communication between the starters and pro-shop especially on frost delay days and the need of new black tees on #6 and #10. Installation of a Black Tee box for hole #6 is not scheduled at this time. Mike indicated are trying to eliminate twosomes, especially when the course is crowded. It was suggested that an information sheet be made up of suggestions to eliminate slow play. Ron suggested that Mike work out the communication problem with his pro-shop personnel.

**6.a. HANDICAP COMMITTEE REPORT:** Doug Snyder, Chair, reported that the committee has had held two meetings. The next meeting will be March 17<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm; any CCGA member may attend this meeting.

**6.b.** Handicap Committee Member, Mimi Wittkamp, reported on the results of the two meetings. The highlights of the meetings are:

1. March 3, 2004 - kick off date for the "Handicap Awareness Campaign".
2. May 3, 2004 - the audits will be resumed.
3. By October 2004 the committee hopes to see a 75% compliance with handicap posting.
4. At this time, the Committee is focusing on educating CCGA members on handicapping. At some point in the future, the Committee will begin communicating one-on-one with members who do not comply with rules relating to posting of accurate scores for handicap purposes.
5. Scorecards will be stamped with a red stamp to remind the player to post scores; posters near the scorecards will remind players to post; there will be a daily check-in sheet at the desk where players will sign in; and a "Handicap Box" will be available to submit questions or comments which may be signed or anonymous.
6. For the Dogfight, Catfight, and Ladies' League one person of a foursome will post all four players. Cards must be signed. Men's Wednesday resident league scores are posted in a separate program and put in at least every other week.
7. The Handicap Committee will audit every winner of each tournament (Oct-Nov) to see how the handicap education program is working.

**6.c.** It was recommended that the pro-shop attendants remind players to post scores and that we need a list of instructions and communications for newcomers.

**7.a: FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Jerry Kothera, Chair, reported that the Committee had reviewed the last three years' income and expenses and that on April 19<sup>th</sup> they will have recommendations on how to spend our funds. Paul Pecoraro stated that the members, in the past, liked having a free golf tournament at the end of the year. Ward Welch asked why the excess money had to be spent – the answer from Doug Snyder was IRS regulations. Paul requested that the decisions be consistent with our mission statement of promoting golf. President Ron indicated that the spending plan would have to be approved (or changed) by the membership at our meeting on April 19<sup>th</sup>.

**8.a. OLD BUSINESS:** Burt Wronsky and Jerry Sullivan have compiled the Dogfight rules and polices. Burt has given Ron a draft that when finalized will be posted. Burt suggested copies be available to new members and posted in several areas when finalized..

**8.b.** Ron reported that on March 3rd Ed Griffin and Jerry Sullivan will take the Johnny Molony Chair to a lady who will embroider the information on a piece of fabric which will be fastened to the chair.

**8.c.** Doug Snyder has installed a new and larger bulletin board in the Member's Room. Ron asked for a volunteer to do signs for headings (e.g. Members Listing, Minutes, etc.). No one volunteered.

**8.d.** Mike Hoffstatter is working on the other outstanding plaques.

**8.e.** Future CCGA meetings will be held on the third Monday of the month beginning in April 2004.

**8.f.** Dan Mulvey reported that he and Bob Armstrong have researched CCGA minutes, old Dogfight info, CCGA Constitution rules info and the photo album in order to recommend ways to convey information to the membership and to reinforce available information. A copy of their full report is attached. Their recommendations are:

1. Continue to compile the minutes, etc. in binders in the Member's Room.
2. Continue the billing monthly inserts.
3. Create a separate binder for the CCGA Constitution and Bylaws, current board members with phone numbers and current member list.
4. Create a separate binder for the Dogfight information and place it on the table with the Dogfight computer.
5. Create a welcome packet with all pertinent information to be given out by the golf club when new members join.
6. Introduce new members at the monthly meetings.
7. On the Members' Room bulletin board include: current men handicaps for men and women, board members and phone numbers, committee chairs and phone numbers, latest event results, minutes, pictures, etc.
8. That the results of the CCGA tournaments be published and put on the Tournament Bulletin Board.

**8g.** President Ron asked Dan Mulvey to chair a CCGA Membership Committee. Dan accepted. President Ron will recruit additional members for this committee.

**8h.** Jerry Sullivan suggested placing a bulletin board in the Men's Room for handicaps, notices, etc.

## **CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING – April 19, 2004**

President, Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm.

**1.MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary, read the minutes of the March 1, 2004 meeting. The minutes were approved as read with the notation to look into Oct-Nov. date in 6.b, #7 of the March 1 minutes. (Upon investigation the notation of Oct-Nov means that the Handicap Committee will audit the winners during that time period for each year.)

**2.INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:** Ron reported that Hank Thurmond indicated that the report that the Golf Club is up for sale is nothing but a rumor.

**3.a.TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder, announced that we had approximately 180 members. The balance in the treasury is \$2,520.91.

**4.a.TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair Phil Stack reported that 81 players participated in the March Par 3 tournament and 66 in the April Captain's Choice Tournament. Tournament results are posted on the bulletin board. The next tournament will be on May 15.

**5.a.PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter reported that the course conditions were improving; the greens were being cut shorter and; the second annual clean-up day was successful. Mike also announced that The Golf club at Cedar Creek was now in partnership with SC National Golf Club in Beaufort, SC and encouraged members to use their facilities. Mike also reinforced the fact that the Golf Club at Cedar Creek was not for sale.

**5.b.** Following are member questions and comments for Mike:

1. Put a notice in the Sandbagger of shotgun tournaments on the weekend and listing other pre-scheduled tournaments.
2. Carts were reported on number three green (the rangers try to discourage this).
3. There should be a shotgun start on Friday evening as long as there are 50-60 players.
4. Where do you take relief at a certain area where there are OB Stakes on #3? (Pat Sullivan will look at the #3 OB Stakes with Mike to try to resolve the relief problem.)
5. Greg Pasco asked about the condition of the #3 and #9 tees. Mike responded that they would soon be sodded.
6. Mike was also asked about when the greens would be fixed and the schedule for tree cleanup from the ice storm. Mike answered that the Poannua could not be treated until fall and that the heat will burn that grass out. At this time it can only be cut short and rolled. The tree cleanup will be scheduled after the greens, etc., are straightened out; he would not give a time line at this time.



7. Bob Levitt mentioned that some sand traps have good sand on the sides but not in the middle. Mike responded that the center is spinned and the sides raked and will have Randy look at them.

**6.a.FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Jerry Kothera, Chair, reported average income and expenditures (within categories) over the past three years. Average monthly income consists of \$300 from Mulligans (after prize money) and \$20.00 for Membership Dues. Average monthly expenses are \$65.00 for refreshments at the monthly meetings, \$50 for Holes-in-One support, \$40 for Charities, \$10 for Office supplies, \$115 for tournament support and \$65 for miscellaneous expenses. (A copy of this report is attached.)

**6.b.** The Committee recommended capping the cost of refreshments at monthly meetings at \$65.00. They also recommended that rather than waiting until December to decide how to spend excess monies that merchandise (approximately \$115) be purchased from the pro shop each month and be raffled off at each tournament. And, if there is enough money we would continue the December free tournament. Currently, there is enough surplus to pay for the December free tournament.

**6.c.** President Phillips stated that he would like to give the committee a sense of how the members would like to spend the surplus monies. After lengthy discussions a motion was made by Dan Mulvey, seconded by Gene Kolkman, to approve the proposed budget as presented with additional clarification on expenditures by the committee. Motion carried.

**7.a.MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:** Dan Mulvey, Chairman, reported that the committee had met and tentatively agreed that their primary mission would be "To support the acquisition of, and provide the necessary process to successfully integrate new members into the CCGA". The basic priorities of the committee are to Develop Process and Communications for assimilating new members successfully into the CCGA; Increasing participation at the CCGA monthly meetings; enhancing communications; and to support with recommendations, etc. the outreach for new CCGA members. This would be through the CC Sales Office and the Golf Club.

**8.a.HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** On May 3 the committee will do another audit and place an insert in the May billing regarding posting of scores. Doug Snyder announced that (effective May 3) to be eligible to win a tournament such as the dogfight, etc., scorecards must be turned in and signed by those listed on the scorecard. The pro shop will have the starters and tournament directors remind the members to sign card and turn them in.

**9.a.OLD BUSINESS:** Current Dogfight rules and Policies have been posted on the bulletin board in the Members' Lounge. Ed Griffin reported that the fabric for the Johnny Molony chair had been embroidered and they were looking for a seamstress to sew it on the back of the chair. President Ron reminded the members to check the bulletin board in the Members' Lounge for notices, minutes, etc. Mike Hoffstatter reported that all the other outstanding plaques had been brought up-to-date.

**10.a. NEW BUSINESS.** A motion was made by Jim Mitchell and seconded that if someone cannot complete a CCGA Tournament (including the Dogfight) due to injury, the necessity to leave due to an emergency situation or a sudden illness, that person should have his tournament monies returned to him. Motion passed.

**10.b.** The question was raised that if someone had a hole-in-one but did not finish playing 18 holes were they entitled to the money in the hole-in-one-jar? Mike Hoffstatter will research this and report back.

**10.c.** A motion was made by Gene Kolkman and seconded that it is the responsibility of the CCGA member to report a hole-in-one to the CCGA Board within 30 days of the occurrence in order to receive a CCGA award. The motion passed.

**10.d.** Doug Snyder made a motion to give Jerry Sullivan and Burt Wronsky \$100 for entering Dogfight scores into the computer and making payouts for the Dogfight competitions. The motion was seconded and carried.

**10.e.** There was considerable discussion regarding the need to press Golf Club management to improve conditions. A number of suggestions were made which President Ron believes are beyond the scope of CCGA and perhaps should be directed by homeowners to the Golf Club at Cedar Creek Owners' Association (GCCCOA). Al Boyer stated that the Thurmonds (Golf Club management) and Koleraks (Cedar Creek management) were in communication with each other.



## **CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING – May 19, 2004**

President, Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm.

**1.MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the April 19, 2004 meeting. The minutes were approved as read with the correction on **Paragraph 6.b., Finance Committee Report**, "that merchandise (approximately \$115) be purchased from the pro shop each month and be raffled off at each tournament on a draw from the Mulligan tickets."

**2.a.TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder, stated that there is a balance of \$2,573.32 in the treasury. A copy is on file

**3.a.TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair Phil Stack reported that 44% of the members who participated in the May 15<sup>th</sup> tournament had won something. The next tournament on June 19 will be low gross and low net. Art Kennedy asked if a guest could participate. The answer was yes if they have a USGA handicap, otherwise they would play scratch.

**4.a.PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter reported that the course conditions are improving; the Poannua and Rye grasses will be burning out and one can expect to see brown spots in the next few weeks; and the bunkers have been improved. Mike reminded everyone that it is important to fill the divots at this time of year with sand and not to replace the divot.

**4.b.** In response to questions at the April Mike stated:

1. That in order to be eligible for Hole-in-One monies a player needs to play nine holes and have at least one witness. If the Hole-in-One pot is over \$500 two witnesses are required.
2. Regarding the question of nearest point of relief on #3 from the cart path between the OB stakes and cart path, he and Pat Sullivan had not had a chance to get together to look at the situation. President Ron asked that they make an effort to get together prior to the next meeting.

**4.c.** Current questions and suggestions responded to by Mike:

1. Jerry Smith noted that bunkers are not being prepared in the mornings when there was a shotgun start. Mike responded that the maintenance people often were not able to get to the sand bunkers until later in the day after mowing, etc. Jerry also mentioned that there often was a ring around the cup holes. Mike will have maintenance check this out.
2. Steve Pfeifer suggested that the maintenance crew need to replace the tee markers properly after mowing.

**5.a.** Art Kennedy announced that he and Kathy have invested in the golf course and he has formed a committee to gather information, comments, and suggestions; and



but would not be involved in the day-to-day management.

**6.a.** Ron, the “Rule Man” gave a presentation on Rule 28 – Ball Unplayable.

**7.a. HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Chairman, Doug Snyder, reintroduced his Committee and reported that its latest survey indicated a significant improvement in the numbers of players entering their scores in the computer. Committee members approached several people and reminded them to post their scores. Most of these members were not posting 9-hole scores and were educated on how they could post. Roy Wright asked if a player could declare a practice round prior to play. Doug answered that at this time, there was not a provision for this.

**7.b.** Doug also related that when a mulligan is used on a hole, a player should post par plus whatever strokes you would have on that particular hole.

**7.c.** Ron commended the Handicap Committee on the job they were doing.

**8.a. FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Jerry Kothera, Chair, reported that the Committee met on May 4 and proposed the following expenditures for the 2004 Budget.

1. Charities: Sponsor the 2004 Breast Cancer Tournament at Cedar Creek with a hole (\$250.00) and donate \$100 to the Silver Bluff High School golf team that uses The Golf club at Cedar Creek as their practice facility.
2. Tournament Support: Expend approximately \$500 for a “free, less cart fee, tournament in both July and December to help build CCGA membership and use the December mulligan revenue to purchase a golf club prize to be given away using the mulligan ticket drawing for a winner.
3. Contingency: Purchase 2-3 Flowering Cherry trees, for a maximum of \$250, to plant along the cart path on #7 hole near the present two trees planted honoring our fallen golf members. These trees would then be dedicated to a fallen member when the appropriate time comes.
4. Golf course improvement: Discuss with Club management the possibility of sharing the cost of installing a new Black Tee at #6 hole. This cost would approximately be \$1,000.

**8.b.** A motion was made by Jerry Sullivan and seconded, to spend \$250.00 on the Breast Cancer Tournament, donate \$100 to the Silver Bluff High School golf team, use \$500 each for the “free” tournaments, less cart fees, in July and December, use the December mulligan revenue to purchase a golf club prize using a mulligan ticket drawing for the winner and purchase the flowering Cherry trees for a maximum of \$250.00 to plant along the cart path on #7 hole near the green to be dedicated to a fallen member when the appropriate time comes. The motion passed. Expenditures for course improvement will be addressed later.

**9.a. OLD BUSINESS:** Ed Griffin stated that the Johnny Molony chair was finished.

Ron announced that anyone who had attended 6 meetings during a 12-month period were entitled to a CCGA straw hat and to check with the CCGA Secretary if interested.

**10.a. NEW BUSINESS:** Ron mentioned that he had requested that the grill be kept open on the CCGA meeting days so members could come in and eat around 5:00 – 5:30. He encouraged members to come early, have something to eat and enjoy fellowship with other CCGA members.

**10.b.** Treasurer, Doug Snyder stated that in the future, there would be a limit of one free drink per person. If there were just a few members present then possibly the limit could be two. A total of \$65.00, including tip, would be the absolute limit.



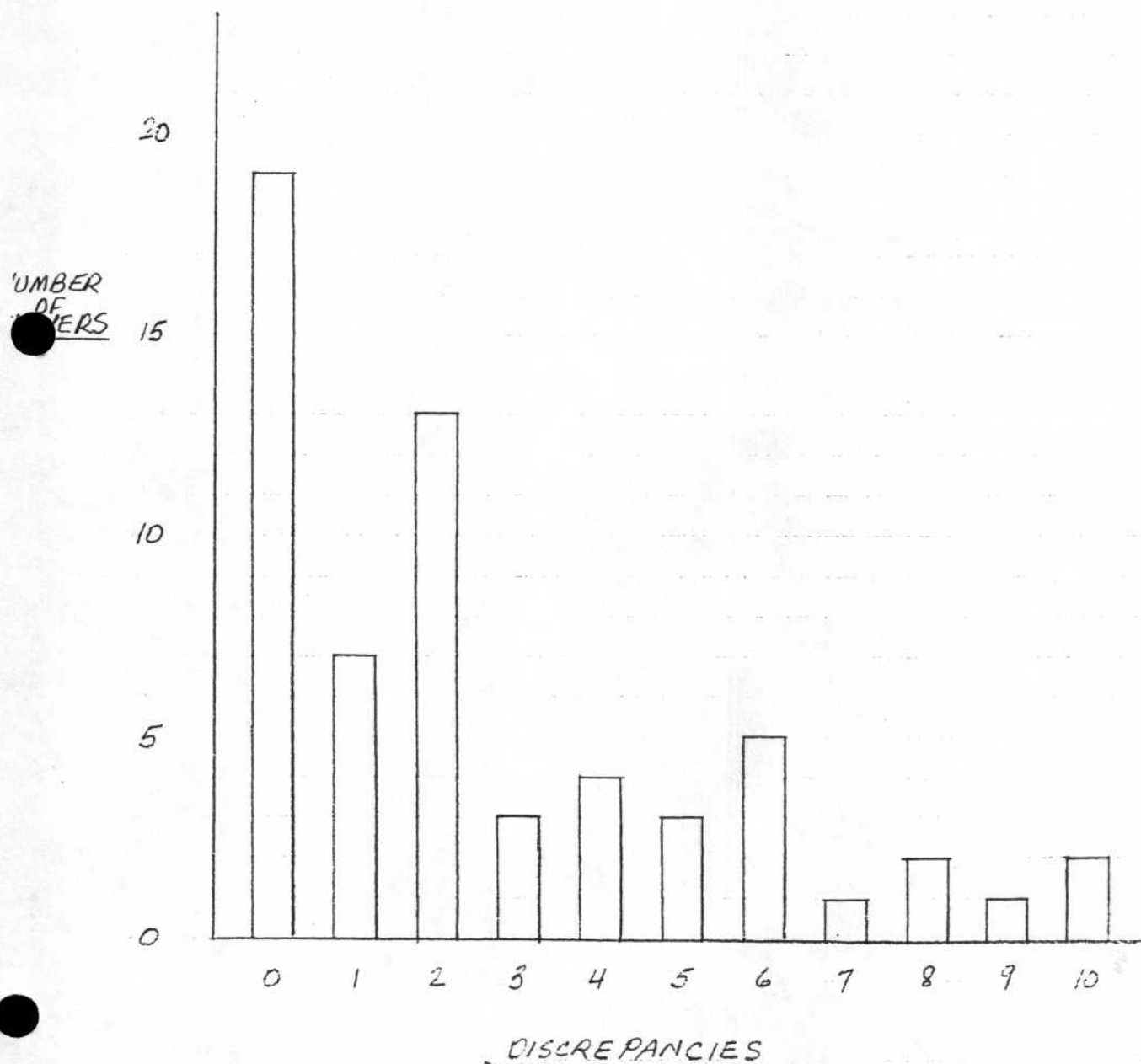

JUNE 21, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:40 pm.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the May 19, 2004. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a. PRESENTATION OF HOLE-IN-ONE AWARDS:** President Phillips awarded Hole-In-One Trophies to Sue Bedard, Jack Bahen and Bill Robinson. Bill Robinson was the only member present to accept his award.

**3.a. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder, stated that the current balance in the treasury is \$2,684.96. Doug introduced Jim Wise as a new member.

**4.a. TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair Al Bowyer reported that 65 players had participated in the June 19 CCGA tournament and that 23 had won something. The next tournament on July 17 will be a modified 4 person scramble. The July tournament will be a "free" tournament with members paying a cart fee only. John Andrews suggested there be a notice of the "free" tournament in next month's *Sandbagger*.

**4.b.** A question was asked if outsiders, non-association members could participate. Those players would have to pay the full cost of the event. Dan Mulvey asked if a person who was not a member of the club could belong to CCGA. The Bylaws state that, "Membership in this association will be open to all golfers who are members in good standing with the Cedar Creek Golf Club."

**5a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter announced that the Club Championship may be held in late September verses August to encourage participation. He mentioned that the CSRA Lady/Pro tournament was a success; that there will be a Junior Clinic in July; there has been one held in June; the Keller Williams Amateur Tournament will be held Saturday, June 24 and today was Member Appreciation day and thanked all those who had participated.

**5.b.** Mike reported that a lot of areas on the course had recently been sodded and those areas are to be considered ground under repair. He mentioned that stump grinding has started and will improve the look of the course; aerification will be early in July and tomorrow, June 22, weather permitting, the course will be limed. Because of a lot of rain the mowing is behind and the rain has been bad for the sand traps.

**5.c.** Current questions and suggestions responded to by Mike:

1. Ron mentioned that there were large piles of branches in the woods on several holes. Would these piles stay or are they to be removed? Mike responded that maintenance will eventually move them. Until they are moved a player may receive a free drop from the piles.

2. Burt Wronsky mentioned that the temporary black tees on the fairway need to be mowed shorter. Mike stated they do not have the equipment or personnel to mow these areas shorter and have tried to find the shortest grassy areas to place the tees.

3. Ron mentioned that at the Saturday tournament some people had to pay for their first beer. Mike responded that in order to keep food costs for tournaments down that free beer had been eliminated. Ron requested Mike to look into selling \$1.00 beer at the tournaments.

4. There was a question regarding improving the ventilation in the dining area. Mike stated the air conditioning had been fixed. There was a suggestion of looking into fans to circulate the air.

5. Several members praised the appearance of the course.

**6.a. MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:** Dan Mulvey, Chair gave a membership report with suggestions and ideas of communicating with potential or new CCGA members. Ron thanked Dan and his committee for all the work they had done and suggested anyone with further suggestions see a committee member. A copy of the report is on file.

**7.a.** Ron, the "Rule Man", gave a presentation on **Rule 27-Ball Lost or Out of Bounds & Provisional Ball.**

**8.a.HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Chairman, Doug Snyder thanked Mike for having the starters remind players to sign their scorecards. The committee is continuing to audit and re-audit. The auditing only applies to CCGA members at this time. Mike will supply a list of non-CCGA members so they can be audited. The results of getting players to post has been better than expected. Ron suggested that measures will be taken to adjust a handicap if a player is continues to ignore policies with respect to the posting of scores.

**9.a.OLD BUSINESS:** Regarding the OB stakes on #3, no decision has been made but the nearest point of relief would be the fairway side of the cart path, no nearer to the hole. A drop area was suggested.

**10.a. NEW BUSINESS:** Regarding the CCGA straw hats: Burt Wronsky had asked if more than one hat could be given to a member; Marty Katz liked giving a hat to a new member. Ron stated that the issue would be discussed at an executive board meeting.

**11.** The next CCGA meeting will be held Monday, July 19.

**12.** The meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.

JULY 19, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm and acknowledged two new members, Walt Powers and Dick Gillette.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the June 21 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer, Doug Snyder, stated that the current balance in the treasury is \$2,218.96 and we currently have 199 members. The report was accepted.

**3a. HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Chairman, Doug Snyder reported that the Committee has audited 140 players; 30 more will be audited in the near future. The Committee has spoken to several players about posting and has clarified posting rules. Paul Pecoraro is auditing the Dogfight. Catfight players are being audited by Mimi Wittkamp. They are making sure correct scores are being posted. Mike Hoffstatter will provide the Committee with a list of non-members to be audited.

**4.a. TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair, Al Bowyer, reported that 69 players had participated in the Saturday, July 17th Modified Captain's Choice Tournament. There were 24 prizes awarded. There is a schedule change - the September tournament will be held in August as the Club Championship will be held in September. There will also be no CCGA tournament in October as the resident's tournament will be held then. Both tournaments are not held in the same month due to lack of participation.

**5.a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike Hoffstatter announced that the course has been aerified but is not completely healed. He reminded players to repair ball marks on the greens even though aerified. Mike reported that some of the sod had been cut and most is in good shape; the maintenance crews are trying to get to the bunker faces for mowing and fixing; some property owners were placing brush piles on the course and the club owners were trying to address this with the Kolareks; on the left side of #18 a trench had to be dug to divert water from property lines and will probably be marked as "ground under repair". Mike will post a notice regarding this. Mike praised the July 17<sup>th</sup> CCGA Tournament and its interesting format. He requested that members look for cart keys - 550 have been misplaced since March - also range bags.

**5.b.** Questions and suggestions responded to by Mike:

1. Doug Snyder asked why the aerification had not been back-filled with sand. Mike responded that because it had rained so much the greens needed to air out. Al Bowyer suggested that Mike give a lesson on how to fix ball marks.

2. Ron Phillips asked if the OB Stakes on #3 could be moved. Mike stated that the stakes couldn't be moved onto the properties of the residents and will be left as they



AUGUST 23, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:33 pm and acknowledged new members.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the July 19 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a. TREASURER'S REPORT:** In the absence of Treasurer, Doug Snyder, Ron reported the current balance in the treasury is \$2,354.28, that \$250.00 will be spent on the "Rally for a Cure Cancer Tournament" in October, \$100 to the Silver Bluff Golf Team, \$250 for Memorial Trees and \$500 towards the December "free" tournament. These expenses were agreed upon at a prior meeting. The treasurer's report was accepted.

Ed Griffin announced and congratulated Barbara Fischer on a Hole-in-One on #8. A trophy will be provided from CCGA funds..

**3a. HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Ron announced that a total of nine audits covering 169 players had been performed by The Committee. Eighteen players had discrepancies, over sixty had none. There were some discrepancies that were explained. The Committee will be re-auditing some players and are drafting a letter to send to non-conforming players.

**3.b.** Paul Pecoraro, Handicap Committee Member, mentioned that the purpose of the audits is to ensure players are posting and posting accurately. To date, only CCGA members have been audited. The Committee will address those players who are members of the Club but not members of CCGA.

**4.a. TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Ron reported that approximately 41 or 42 players had participated in the August tournament with about 50% of the players winning something. There will not be another CCGA tournament until November.

**5.a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Wes Thurmond gave the Pro Shop Report for Mike. He announced that the Club Championship will be held September 25 and 26. Sign up sheets are available on the bulletin board in the foyer. He reported that a secondary aerification will be done shortly and reminded the members to repair ball marks. The course condition is good with only a few problems. Overseeding will take place in the second or third week in September. Wes encouraged the members to sign up for the Cancer Tournament taking place October 2 and announced that the Monday August 30 tournament had been cancelled.

**5.b** President Phillips thanked Art Kennedy for all the work Art and his committee has done on the course.

**6.a.** Ron, **The Rule Man**, presented rules on "Loose Impediments and Ball in Motion".

8.a. NEW BUSINESS: As announced in the above Treasurer's Report, CCGA will buy a hole for the "Rally for a Cure Cancer Tournament".

8.b. Marty Katz stated that there had been a problem several weeks ago regarding a young man who had played (and qualified) from the blue tees rather than the white tees in a Dogfight and had finished in the money but was denied his reward.

A motion was made by Marty that: "The Dogfight Rules should be amended to state clearly that a person be allowed to play a Dogfight round from the tee that he or she is permitted by USGA rules to play providing that they qualify and maintain qualification from each of those tees according to the Dogfight Rules. Once the player has selected the playing tee for the round, the player must play from that tee for the entire round or be disqualified." The motion was seconded and carried.

8.c. Marty also moved that: "Restitution shall be made to Dan Mulvey's son and an apology issued by the CCGA as well as payment from the Treasury for the award money he would have won for his ranking for the round. His scores should be manually corrected to indicate that the rounds were played from the blue tees". President Ron indicated that he supported paying the player what his standing in the Dogfight competition was on that day. But, Ron stated that while some may disagree with the decision made on the day of the incident, he does not believe that an apology should be made because it connotes some wrong doing on the part of the decision-makers who had to make an on the spot decision. The motion was seconded and carried.

8.d. Paul Pecorarro made a motion: "That the Dogfight time be changed to 10:00 a.m. beginning the first Tuesday after Labor Day." The motion was seconded but defeated.

8e. Pat Sullivan stated that after a Dogfight some men had an issue with the women participating in the Dogfight. Pat had reminded the men, and the audience, that the CCGA was made up of both men and women and the women were entitled to play in the Dogfight just as the men were entitled to play in the Catfight if they wish.

8.f. Dan Mulvey stated that his Committee had made a recommendation to place tees or divot tools with CCGA logo on them in the golf carts. Ron suggested that this discussion be tabled until a further date.



SEPTEMBER 20, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm and updated the membership on the status of the health of George Kowalczyk.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the August 23 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2.a PRESIDENT'S ANNOUNCEMENT:** Ron announced that the Treasurer and Vice-president (Doug Snyder and Jerry Kothera) of the CCGA have resigned and as per the CCGA Constitution he needs to replace them. Paul Pecoraro has agreed to fill both vacancies until the next election. Doug has also resigned from the Handicap Committee. ## **RULES OF THE CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION DOGFIGHT**

Effective this date, this is **the only document** (other than computer software and instructions for entering information into the Dogfight Computer) **used to regulate the CCGA Dogfight**. If a **prior rule** has been **omitted** from this document, **it is not now in effect**. **Revisions** of this document may be accomplished **by motions approved at CCGA meetings**. **Disagreements** regarding the interpretation of any aspect of this document will be **adjudicated by the CCGA Executive Board in an ad hoc meeting**. In such cases, it **may be necessary to defer the payout of a Dogfight**.

### **FORMAT OF PLAY**

1. The Dogfight is **individual competition**. Each player plays his/her own ball without handicap.
2. The format of the dogfight is **MODIFIED STABLEFORD** (with points allocated as indicated below.)

BOGEY	1 POINT
PAR	2 POINTS
BIRDIE	3 POINTS
EAGLE	4 POINTS
DOUBLE EAGLE	5 POINTS

3. A player's place in the competition is determined by how many points he/she exceeds or falls short of his/her "target" (see Establishment of Target below.) For example, a player whose "target" is 20 points and who made 22 points is "plus 2." This player would place higher than a player who was "minus 1" and lower than a player who was "plus 6" compared to their "targets." **The point to remember is that your place in the competition is based on how many points you made compared to your "target."**

### **ESTABLISHMENT OF TARGET**

4. **Each player in the Dogfight must establish a "target" score(s) which then becomes the baseline to compute his/her score for each Dogfight competition.** The "target(s)" is recomputed after each competition and **may be established for multiple tees**. Players will establish their target(s) playing from their appropriate tees as follows:
  - a. **A player must compete in the Dogfight three times to establish a "target" from each set of tees from which the player wishes to play.** The "target" is determined by averaging the best three point totals of the last five dogfights played from each tee. If a player has played only three times from a tee, then it is the average of the three; if only four times, it is the average of the three best of the four.
  - b. **A player who wishes to have the option to play from multiple tees (e.g. one set one day and one set another day) may establish targets for more than one set of tees.**

*Sept 30, 2004*



c. In order to play from the black tees, a player must be 65 years old or older or have had a Handicap Index of 22.0 or higher from the white tees before switching to the black tees. The player may continue to play from the black tees even though his Handicap Index becomes less than 22.0.

d. A player not playing in a dogfight for 6 months must reestablish his/her "target(s)."

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PRIZES**

5. Players are eligible to win only prizes for closest to the pin until they have established their "target(s)" by playing in three Dogfights from the same tees. On their fourth round, they are eligible for all prizes.

6. All players must check in on the Dogfight computer before starting the round or no later than the start of play on the back nine holes to be eligible for any prize money. There is no refund of the entry fee if you do not check in on the computer.

7. Each player must sign his/her score card before turning it in. Failure to do so will result in disqualification; the entry fee will not be refunded.

### **SCHEDULE OF PLAY**

8. Normally, the Dogfight is held on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

9. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, the starting time (shotgun start) is 9am beginning with the first Tuesday after the start of daylight savings time to the first Tuesday after 1 November. The Start Time changes to 10am on the first Tuesday after 1 November to the 1st Tuesday after the start of daylight savings time.

10. On Saturdays, the starting time (tee times rather than shotgun) is 9am throughout the year. Please sign up in the blue book at the desk in the Pro Shop by Wednesday if you wish to play in the Saturday dogfight.

### **ENTRY FEE**

11. On Tuesday and Thursdays the Entry Fee is \$5.00.

12. On Saturdays the Entry Fee is \$10.00.

13. The entry fee will be refunded to a player who is unable to complete the Dogfight due to an injury, sudden illness or other emergency situation.

### **GENERAL RULES OF PLAY**

14. Participants may play the Dogfight from any set of tees( EXCEPTION: MEN MAY NOT PLAY FROM THE RED TEES), providing that he/she has qualified and remains

qualified from the tees selected for play on a particular day (see "ESTABLISHMENT OF TARGET" above.)

15. Once the player has selected the playing tees when he/she signs in on the computer for the round, the player must play from those tees for the entire round or be disqualified. Therefore, **it is important**

**that players switching tees understand how to properly sign in on the computer when switching tees. It is the player's responsibility to seek assistance, if necessary, to properly sign up in the computer when switching tees.**

**16. There are no mulligans.**

**17. Pick up after double bogey.**

**18. Dogfights are played under USGA Rules unless otherwise specified. Play the ball as it lies except;**

a. lift clean and place in the player's own fairway, one club length on holes where "cart path only" is established by the Pro Shop (this is done often due to heavy rain) or;

b. when an Association Temporary Rule, such as "lift, clean and place," has been established.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

19. During inclement weather, the Dogfight is considered official if more than 50% of the field completes play (i.e. all eighteen holes). If official, those who do not complete play are eligible only for closest to the pin payouts and will not have their entry fees refunded. If not official, entry fees will be refunded to all players. In any case, players not completing the round should turn in a score card marked "withdrew."

### **PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY**

20. A pool of money is created for distribution. The pool consists of the total of all entry fees paid by the participants. The pool will be reduced to zero in accordance with the following:

a. A predetermined amount (closest to the hole pool) is set aside for the closest to the hole on each Par 3. The shot on the green closest to the hole on a Par 3 will win 25% of the closest to the hole pool. If fewer than four such shots occur, the closest to the hole pool will be divided by the number of qualified shots.

b. The total pool less the amount provided in "a" above will be paid to participants whose points scored are most favorable to their "target points." A predetermined schedule, available for inspection, shows the number and amounts of payouts to be made.

c. A participant is not required to be present at the time of payout to win. The official scorer will leave unclaimed money in the Dogfight box in the Pro Shop for future distribution.



d. Any prize money unclaimed for six months will be forfeited and placed in the hole-in-one fund.

# CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING

OCTOBER 18, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm, acknowledged a member who had not attended a prior meeting, Frank Cerra, and reminded the members to add their e-mail addresses on the list provided.

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the September 20<sup>th</sup> meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2. HOLE-IN-ONE:** Ron announced that he had presented Glenn Huey with a Hole-in-One trophy at the Resident's Tournament on Saturday, October 16 as Glenn was not able to attend this meeting. Glen had a Hole-in-One on October 6 on Hole #5 with a Pitching Wedge.

**3. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Paul Pecoraro stated that the current balance in the treasury is \$1,915.57 and that there are two small outstanding bills amounting to approximately \$40.00. The Treasurer's report was accepted as read. A copy is on file.

**4.a HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Paul reported that audits had been performed. Mimi had audited two Dogfights and was pleased with the accuracy of the postings. However, the posting rate had dropped to 60%. Mimi has also audited twelve non CCGA members. Nine out of twelve have posted more than 70% of the time. Paul will call those not conforming.

**4.b.** Ward Welch asked if a penalty would be implemented if a member is not posting correctly especially if they have won a Dogfight. Ron answered that up to now we have been in an "education mode" regarding the posting requirements, but that in the near future we will take a more aggressive posture and penalties may be implemented. Paul answered other questions regarding tournament scores and how they impact one's handicap.

**4.c.** Paul also mentioned that the Cat Fight participants had been audited and they were 100% in compliance! Paul then explained course rating and slope and gave out a handout describing the handicapping difference of using multiple tees.

**5.TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Ron announced that the next CCGA Tournament would be the "Bubba" Tournament on Saturday, November 13. All players may use one mulligan on each hole.

**6.a. PRO SHOP REPORT:** Mike thanked all those who had participated in the "Rally for A Cure" Tournament. The turnout was wonderful and the tournament was a huge success. CCGA has received a letter of thanks for the hole sponsorship and participation.

(The letter is posted on the small CCGA Bulletin Board in the Members' Lounge.)

Mike stated that nine resident members and 21 outside members had participated in the Club Championship and was very disappointed in the lack of participation. Mike would like to know what the club can do to make the Club Championship more of a success.

**6.a.** Mike reported that over-seeding has taken place and it looks like it will be a good year for winter grass. Fairways are being cut as fast as possible. He reminded the members that it is important to fix ball marks on the green at all times including during over-seeding and aerating times. Earl Bennett also reminded the members that divots on the tee boxes need to be filled. Mike answered other questions regarding cutting on the greens and placement of the sand boxes. Gene Reardon stated that he would remind the members of the Resident's League to fix ball marks and fill in divots.

**7. MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:** Dan Mulvey stated that a welcoming letter has been completed and is ready to go into a membership package. There are a few other items that need to be taken care of including costing of programs. Ron mentioned that he was addressing club-to-club play and that Mike had contacted the Pro at Midland Valley who requested a list of requirements for the tournaments.


**10.c.** Paul Pecoraro asked if members would be interested in a Senior Match Play Tournament. Ron stated he will investigate.

# CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING

NOVEMBER 15, 2004

President Ron Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, welcomed everyone and acknowledge new members Robert P. Richardson and John Turner. Ron announced that he had sent cards to George Kowalczyk and Pat Sullivan and CCGA will make a donation to the Heart Association in member of Jerry Sullivan

**1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The Secretary read the minutes of the October 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

**2. TREASURER'S REPORT:** Paul Pecoraro stated that the current balance in the treasury is \$1,803.70. Unpaid obligations are \$100 to the Silver Bluff Golf Team and up to \$250 for memorial trees as provided for in the budget. All other expenses and income are consistent with the budget.

**3. TOURNAMENT CHAIR REPORT:** Co-chair, Phil Stack, reported that 76 players had participated in the "Bubba" Tournament and 41% of the participants had won something. The next tournament will be held Saturday, December 4 and is a Stableford Format. The tournament is a "free" tournament with non-cart memberships paying only cart fees. **4.a HANDICAP COMMITTEE:** Paul Pecoraro reported that Mimi Wittkamp had audited an entire Dogfight. One person had not posted and one person had not posted correctly. Audits will continue on a monthly basis.

**4.b.** Burt Wronsky asked if the course would be re-rated due to the additional OB's and other changes. Ron asked Wes to find out the answer to the question from Mike.

**5.a PRO SHOP REPORT:** Wes represented the Pro Shop. He reminded the members that on Thanksgiving Day there would be a 9 am shotgun and requested players to call the Pro Shop to sign up. There will be a sale in the Pro Shop some time after Thanksgiving. Wes also reminded the members to call the Pro Shop in case of any frost delays.

4. Burt Wronsky stated that he would like to see the calendar listed in the *Sandbagger* be extended into the following month so that if there are any tournaments scheduled regular players may make other arrangements.

**6. MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:** Dan Mulvey reported that new member packages are available in the Pro Shop. The Committee continues to work on several other projects. Peggy Katz will look into providing CCGA information in the Cedar Creek Community Newsletter.

**7. OLD BUSINESS:** Ron had asked for ideas for inter league play. If anyone has any suggestions get back to him ASAP. Ron had also requested input on why there has been low participation of Cedar Creek residents in the Club Championship and CCGA tournaments. He has received a handful of comments but would like more. Ron reported that nothing had been done yet for Senior Match Play.

A motion was made, seconded and approved unanimously to accept the slate of officers as presented.



2. Motion made by Jim Mitchell and seconded that if someone cannot complete a CCGA Tournament (including the Dogfight) due to injury, the necessity to leave due to an emergency situation or a sudden illness, that person should have his tournament monies returned to him. Motion passed.
3. Motion made by Gene Kolkman and seconded that it is the responsibility of the CCGA member to report a hole-in-one to the CCGA Board within 30 days of the occurrence in order to receive a CCGA award. The motion passed.
4. Doug Snyder made a motion to give Jerry Sullivan and Burt Wronsky \$100 for entering Dogfight scores into the computer and making payouts for the Dogfight competitions. The motion was seconded and carried.

### **May 19, 2004: (Paragraph 8.b.)**

1. A motion was made by Jerry Sullivan and seconded, to spend \$250.00 on the Breast Cancer Tournament, donate \$100 to the Silver Bluff High School golf team, use \$500 each for the "free" tournaments, less cart fees, in July and December, use the December mulligan revenue to purchase a golf club prize using a mulligan ticket drawing for the winner and purchase the flowering Cherry trees for a maximum of \$250.00 to plant along the cart path on #7 hole near the green to be dedicated to a fallen member when the appropriate time comes. The motion passed.

Motion made by Marty Katz that: "The Dogfight Rules should be amended to state clearly that a person be allowed to play a Dogfight round from the tee that he or she is permitted by USGA rules to play providing that they qualify and maintain qualification from each of those tees according to the Dogfight Rules. Once the player has selected the playing tee for the round, the player must play from that tee for the entire round or be disqualified". The motion was seconded and carried.
2. Motion made by Marty Katz that: "Restitution shall be made to Dan Mulvey's son and an apology issued by the CCGA as well as payment from the Treasury for the award money he would have won for his ranking for the round. His scores should be manually corrected to indicate that the rounds were played from the blue tees". The motion was seconded and carried.

## **September 20, 2004 (Paragraph 9.b.)**

1. Mimi Wittkamp made a motion to accept the Dogfight Rules as presented by Ron. The motion was seconded and passed. (Dogfight Rules are posted on the Members' Lounge Bulletin Board and near the Dogfight Computer in the Pro Shop).

## **November 15, 2004 (Paragraph 8.b)**

Paul Pecoraro moved that a committee be formed to look into AED equipment, costs, communications, pro shop participation, liabilities, etc. for the club. Luanne Langmo seconded the motion. The motion carried.
