Golf Rule Changes for 2008

The most significant change that took effect on Jan. 1, 2008 has to do with identifying a ball lying in a hazard. Previously players were not permitted to lift a ball for identification when the ball lay in a hazard. Under the revised rules, players are permitted, by Rule 12-2, to lift a ball lying in a hazard in order to identify it and it will be a violation of Rule 15-3 if a wrong ball is played from any part of the course.

The penalty for violation of Rule 15-3 (playing a wrong ball) will be a twostroke penalty in stroke play or the loss of hole penalty in match play.

OTHER CHANGES:

1. Carrying but not using a non-conforming club will result in a penalty of two strokes per hole, with a maximum penalty of four strokes (stroke play). In match play, an adjustment to the status of a match would be made, with the maximum penalty being two holes.

Note: A non-conforming club can be declared out of play before teeing off on the first teeing ground. However in order to prevent any issues from developing or forgetting to declare a club out of play it is recommended that a non-conforming club not be carried during play.

- 2. Rule 19-2 has been amended to a one-stroke penalty in both match play and stroke play. Previously a ball accidentally deflected by a player, his partner or either of their caddies or equipment resulted in a two-stroke penalty (stroke play) or loss of hole (match play).
- 3.ADVICE: Amended to allow the exchange of information on distance, as it is not considered to be "advice".
- 4. A change to Rule 3-2a clarifies that it is permissible for a cash prize to be accepted for a hole-in-one made while playing golf.

MEMO: To the Members at the Golf Club at Cedar Creek

In order to better accommodate all of our golfing members, The Golf Club at Cedar Creek will make the following changes effective Thursday, March 6th.

- We will implement a shotgun start specifically for our Ladies' 18 hole and 9 hole golfers. The shotgun will begin at 9:00 on Thursdays. The golf course will open for the Dogfight beginning at 11:00.
- The Friday Residents' play and the Saturday Dogfights will have specific tee times and deadlines to sign up your foursomes. Copies of the tee sheets are enclosed.
- We will monitor these changes and make adjustments if/as necessary.





ADJUSTING SCORES:

INCOMPLETE HOLES OR CONCEDED STROKES:

If you pick up on a hole or are conceded a stroke, record the score you most likely would have made. It is the number of strokes (including penalty strokes) taken thus far plus the number of strokes it will take you to complete the hole from that point. An "X" should precede the score on the scorecard. I played a hole like a champ in only 4 strokes but my opponent was left for a putt for a 6 from 15 feet away so I conceded his putt to him. Therefore my opponent would record x-7 on the card. He had taken 5 strokes already and he would have needed two more strokes in most cases to finish the hole. Keep in mind that a player cannot put down more than his equitable strokes and in this case my opponents equitable stroke control number was 7.

HOLES NOT PLAYED:

When a hole isn't played, your score for the hole is par, plus any handicap strokes to which you are entitled based on your full course handicap. This also applies to any hole that you do not play by the Rules of Golf. For example, when I beat my opponent in our match on the 17th hole, if we hadn't played the 18th hole, I would have written down an x-5 for me and an x-6 for my opponent for the hole not played. It was a par 4 and my handicap on that hole was one stroke and for my opponent it was 2 strokes.

POSTING YOUR SCORE:

- Post scores from home and away courses.
- Post scores in all forms of play; match play, stroke play, even team competitions in which you are requested to pick up.
- Post your score when you play at least 13 holes out of 18-holes or at least 7 of 9 holes. On the holes you didn't play, record a par plus any handicap strokes you would have received.

DON'T POST THESE SCORES:

- If you have played fewer than 13 holes (Remember you still have an acceptable 9-hole score).
- When you play in a competition limiting the types of clubs used, such as a oneclub or irons-only tournament.
- When a majority of the holes aren't played under the Rules of Golf, as in a "scramble".

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q. If we quit after I lose a match, 4 and 3, I haven't completed 18 holes. How do I turn in a score?

A. For the holes that you didn't play, record a par, plus any handicap strokes you would have received using your full Course Handicap.

Q. If I pick up on a hole, what score do I post?

A. For handicap purposes, record the score you most likely would have made – BUT, that score must not exceed your equitable Stroke Control Limit.

Q. If we play "winter rules" or "preferred lies", does it affect my score.

A. The USGA doesn't endorse winter rules for several reasons and advises against using them. If however, winter rules are in effect, scores must be posted unless the committee in charge of a particular event decides differently. Long term use of preferred lies will tend to lower scores and lower your handicap index which will put you at a disadvantage against other players who don't use preferred lies.





RULES OF THE CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION DOGFIGHT

Effective this date, this is the only document (other than computer software and instructions for entering information into the Dogfight Computer) used to regulate the CCGA Dogfight. If a prior rule has been omitted from this document, it is not now in effect. Revisions of this document may be accomplished by motions approved at CCGA meetings. Disagreements regarding the interpretation of any aspect of this document will be adjudicated by the CCGA Executive Board in an ad hoc meeting. In such cases, it may be necessary to defer the payout of a Dogfight.

FORMAT OF PLAY

- 1. The Dogfight is an individual stroke play competition. Each player plays his/her own ball without handleap.
- 2. The format of the Dogfight is STABLEFORD as defined by USGA Rule 32-1 b (with points allocated as indicated below).

DOUBLE EAGLE	5 POINTS

3. A player's place in the competition is determined by how many points he/she exceeds or falls short of his/her "target" (see Establishment of Target below). For example, a player whose "target" is 20 points and who made 22 points is "plus 2". This player would place higher than a player who was "minus 1" and lower than a player who was "plus 6" compared to their "targets". The point to remember is that your place in the competition is based on how many points you made compared to your "target".

15. Once the player has selected the playing tees when he/she signs in on the computer for the round, the player must play from those tees for the entire round or be disqualified. Therefore, it is important that players switching tees understand how to properly sign in on the computer when switching tees. It is the player's responsibility to seek assistance, if necessary, to properly sign up in the computer when switching tees.

- 16. There are no mulligans.
- 17. Putt out on all holes. But if you cannot score a point, pick up, to help speed up play, and follow the USGA procedures for recording the gross score for an uncompleted hole.

RULES OF THE CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION DOGFIGHT

Effective this date, this is the only document (other than computer software and instructions for entering information into the Dogfight Computer) used to regulate the CCGA Dogfight. If a prior rule has been omitted from this document, it is not now in effect. Revisions of this document may be accomplished by motions approved at CCGA meetings. Disagreements regarding the interpretation of any aspect of this document will be adjudicated by the CCGA Executive Board in an ad hoc meeting. In such cases, it may be necessary to defer the payout of a Dogfight.

FORMAT OF PLAY

- 1. The Dogfight is an **individual stroke play competition**. Each player plays his/her own ball without handicap.
- 2. The format of the Dogfight is **STABLEFORD** as defined by USGA Rule 32-1 b (with points allocated as indicated below).

BOGEY	1 POINT
PAR	2 POINTS
BIRDIE	3 POINTS
EAGLE	4 POINTS
DOUBLE EAGLE	5 POINTS

3. A player's place in the competition is determined by how many points he/she exceeds or falls short of his/her "target" (see Establishment of Target below). For example, a player whose "target" is 20 points and who made 22 points is "plus 2". This player would place higher than a player who was "minus 1" and lower than a player who was "plus 6" compared to their "targets". The point to remember is that your place in the competition is based on how many points you made compared to your "target".

ESTABLISHMENT OF TARGET

- 4. Each player in the Dogfight must establish a "target" score(s) which then becomes the baseline to compute his/her score for each Dogfight competition. The "target(s)" is recomputed after each competition and may be established for multiple tees. Players will establish their target(s) playing from their appropriate tees as follows:
 - a. A player must compete in the Dogfight three times to establish a "target" from each set of tees from which the player wishes to play. The "target" is determined by averaging the best three point totals of the last five Dogfights played from each tee. If a player has played only three times from a tee, then it is the average of the three; if only four times, it is the average of the three best of the four.
 - b. A player who wishes to have the option to play from multiple tees (e.g. one set one day and one set another day) may establish targets for more than one set of tees.

c. A player not playing in a Dogfight for 6 months must re-establish his/her "target(s)".

ELIGIBILITY FOR PRIZES

- 5. Players are eligible to win only prizes for closest to the pin until they have established their "target(s)" by playing in three Dogfights from the same tees. On their fourth round, they are eligible for all prizes.
- 6. All players must check in on the Dogfight computer before starting the round or no later than the start of play on the back nine holes to be eligible for any prize money. There is no refund of the entry fee if you do not check in on the computer.
- 7. Each player must sign his/her score card before turning it in. Failure to do so will result in disqualification; the entry fee will not be refunded.

SCHEDULE OF PLAY

- 8. Normally, the Dogfight is held on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
- 9. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, the starting time (shotgun start) is 9am beginning with the first Tuesday after the start of daylight savings time to the first Tuesday after 1 November. The Start Time changes to 10am on the first Tuesday after 1 November to the 1st Tuesday after the start of daylight savings time. Start times are subject to change by the Pro Shop.
- 10. On Saturdays, the starting time (tee times rather than shotgun) is 9am throughout the year. Please sign up in the Dogfight book at the desk in the Pro Shop by Tuesday if you wish to play in the Thursday or Saturday Dogfight.

ENTRY FEE

- 11. On Tuesday and Thursdays the Entry Fee is \$5.00.
- 12. On Saturdays the Entry Fee is \$10.00.
- 13. The entry fee will be refunded to a player who is unable to complete the Dogfight due to an injury, sudden illness or other emergency situation.

GENERAL RULES OF PLAY

- 14. Participants may play the Dogfight from any set of tees for which the course has been rated by the South Carolina Golf Association, providing that he/she has qualified and remains qualified from the tees selected for play on a particular day (see "ESTABLISHMENT OF TARGET" above).
- 15. Once the player has selected the playing tees when he/she signs in on the computer for the round, the player must play from those tees for the entire round or be disqualified. Therefore, it is important that players switching tees understand how to properly sign in on the

Cedar Creek Golf Association

computer when switching tees. It is the player's responsibility to seek assistance, if necessary, to properly sign up in the computer when switching tees.

- 16. There are no mulligans.
- 17. Putt out on all holes. But if you cannot score a point, pick up, to help speed up play, and follow the USGA procedures for recording the gross score for an uncompleted hole.
- 18. Dogfights are played under USGA Rules, and any permanent or temporary Local Rules. If you participate in the club's Handicap System, post your gross score, properly adjusted if necessary according to USGA procedures, in the handicap computer after your round.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

19. During inclement weather, the Dogfight is considered official if more than 50% of the field completes play (i.e. all eighteen holes). If official, those who do not complete play are eligible only for closest to the pin payouts and will not have their entry fees refunded. If not official, entry fees will be refunded to all players. In any case, players not completing the round should turn in a score card marked "withdrew". USGA procedures for posting scores for partial rounds must be followed.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- 20. A pool of money is created for distribution. The pool consists of the total of all entry fees paid by the participants. The pool will be reduced to zero in accordance with the following:
 - a. A predetermined amount (closest to the pin pool) is set aside for the closest to the hole on each Par 3. The shot on the green closest to the hole on a Par 3 will win 25% of the closest to the pin pool. If fewer than four such shots occur, the closest to the pin pool will be divided by the number of qualified shots.
 - b. The total pool less the amount provided in "a" above will be paid to participants whose points scored are most favorable to their "target points". A predetermined schedule, available for inspection, shows the number and amounts of payouts to be made.
 - c. A participant is not required to be present at the time of the payout to win. The official scorer will leave unclaimed money in the Dogfight box in the Pro Shop for future distribution.
 - d. Any prize money unclaimed for six months will be forfeited and placed in the hole-inone fund.

October 21, 2008

Greg Pasco called the meeting to order and welcomed all those present to the first meeting of the new CCGA executive board. The meeting was attended by 25 members.

1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING

There were no corrections, additions or changes to the minutes of the September 2008 annual meeting and they were declared accepted as posted.

2. TREASURER'S REPORT – Bob Costanzo

Bob reported the balance in the treasury for fiscal year ending September 31, 2008 at \$3,784.93. The treasury balance ending October 21, 2008 is 5,102.13. Bob Costanzo – Thank you to Andrew Wilson for keeping fantastic records that made the transition extremely easy.

HOLE-IN-ONE CLUB

The Golf Club at Cedar Creek manages the Hole-in-One (HIO) Club. Their rules include:

- The HIO Club is open to all members of The Golf Club at Cedar Creek who are in good standing with active memberships.
- The Fund for the HIO Club is maintained by the Club and is paid out for witnessed holes-in-one. The amount paid out is dependant on how much money is in the fund at the time of the HIO. If two or more holes-in-one occur on the same day, claims will be addressed in sequence, based on the time of day the HIO occurred.
- 3) Hole-in-one claims must be made to the golf club pro shop immediately following the round. Information provided must include the name of the player, the hole number, the club used, the tee from which the shot was played, the time of day and the name(s) of the witness(es).
- To enter for a chance to win any accumulated money in the HIO Club Fund, the entrant must contribute fifty cents (\$0.50) to the HIO Club prior to playing their round. Playing multiple rounds in the same day requires multiple contributions of fifty cents to the HIO Club Fund.
- 5) A minimum of nine holes must be played to qualify for a payout for a hole-in-one.
- 6) If less that \$500 is in the HIO Fund, one (1) witness other than the player is required. If more than \$500 is in the HIO Fund, the event must be witnessed by two (2) persons other than the player making the hole-in-one. Hole-in-one claims made by solo players will not be recognized.
- 7) The Hole-in-One Club is intended for holes-in-one made at The Golf Club at Cedar Creek. Claims of a HIO made at other clubs will not be recognized.

CCGA HOLE-IN-ONE SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES

In addition to the rules set forth by The Golf Club at Cedar Creek regarding the Hole-in-One Club, the CCGA provides the following:

- If a CCGA member in good standing makes a hole-in-one and has complied with the HIO Club rules, that member is entitled to receive from the CCGA a commemorative plaque acknowledging the achievement, and will have their name added to the Hole-in-One plaque in the members' lounge.
- It is the responsibility of the CCGA member to report a HIO to the CCGA Executive Board within thirty (30) days of the occurrence in order to receive a CCGA award.
- The CCGA will guarantee a minimum of \$100 to its members who make a hole-in-one and have complied with the rules of the Hole-in-One Club. This minimum will come into play when the money in the HIO Club Fund is less than \$100. The Club will pay out whatever the current amount is in the HIO Club Fund and the CCGA will make up the difference up to \$100.

Example: The HIO Club has \$60,

A CCGA Member makes a hole-in-one,

Club pays member \$60, CCGA pays member \$40, Member receives \$100.

Example: The HIO Club Fund has \$200,

Two CCGA members make holes-in-one on the same day, The CCGA member who made the first HIO at 9am

receives \$200 from the HIO Club Fund,

The second CCGA member who made the second HIO at

2pm receives \$100 from the CCGA.
