

CEDAR CREEK GOLF ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

January 20, 2009

Greg Pasco called the meeting to order and welcomed all those present. There were no new members present this evening. The meeting was attended by 19 members.

This evening's guest speaker has been rescheduled to our February meeting.

1. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING

There were no corrections, additions or changes to the minutes of the December 2008 meeting and they were declared accepted as posted.

2. TREASURER'S REPORT – Bob Costanzo was home recuperating Greg Pasco reported

Greg reported the balance in the treasury ending January 20, 2009 is \$5,451.10. Greg explained the debits and credits to the account. There are 163 current association members.

3. PROGRAM & EVENTS COMMITTEE - Dan Mulvey

As Greg stated, Sean Daly from South Aiken Physical Therapy will be our guest speaker at our February meeting.

Dan once again thanked the members present for completing the survey last month. Based on the results from that survey the committee has decided to hold fewer events that will be done well. The committee chose four main events for 2009. The first event will be a Wine Tasting and Pairing Event to be held on Tuesday, March 31, 2009. Sue Mulvey will be heading up this event. The second event will be The Creeker Crystal Cup, two Ryder Cup formatted events (27 holes for each, Men's and Ladies) to be held in late April or Early May. Dan will be heading up this event. The third event will be a new and more exciting Match Play Tournament to be held in early summer. This event will be headed by Craig Ellis. The final event for 2009 will be The Fall Member/Member Tournament headed up by Bill Ely. More information will be forth coming. reported that Laurie has agreed to offer "Tips from the Pro" as we have done at previous meetings.

4. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE – Steve Santos & Mike Lesick

Neither Mike nor Steve was available to report this evening but Greg did remind members that the CCGA Par 3 Tournament was postponed from last weekend to this Saturday, January 24th. There was still room on the sign-up sheet for additional players. The next CCGA tournament is scheduled for February 7th.

5. HANDICAP/RULES COMMITTEE – George Montgomery/Mickey Collins

George was at a Rules Seminar being held at Hounds Lake and will have a report next month. Mickey was also at the rules seminar but Paul reported that the handicap committee will have a report next month and to please keep posting your scores.

6. CLUB REPORT –Laurie

Laurie arrived late after attending the Rules Seminar but was able to report that as previously discussed stickers are now on the bunker rakes instructing members to please keep the rakes in the bunker. On Saturday the 24th of January the course maintenance department will be applying chemicals to the front nine to control the crab grass. The front nine will be closed on the afternoon of the 24th and all day on the 25th. On Saturday, the 31st of January they will apply those chemicals to the back nine. The back nine will be closed the afternoon of the 31st and all day on the first of February. Laurie was asked whether carts could be driven in waste bunkers. The answer was; Please don't. Maintenance doesn't rake the waste bunkers everyday so any ruts made by carts will remain until maintenance grooms the bunker.

Katherine reported that the community e-mail for the February specials will be going out soon. The February Happy Hour is on Wednesday, February 11th. Katherine also reported that, sadly, Annette's 18 month old granddaughter passed away on Sunday from complications from Leukemia. 7. NEW BUSINESS

Greg read an e-mail received by the CCGA from Jason Goings, the Silver Bluff High School golf coach. He once again thanked us for our support of their Regional Tournament last year. He then went on to ask if any of our members had old equipment that we would be willing to donate to the team. The high school is one of mixed demographics and a wide range of socioeconomic standings. It would be a great help if they could get clubs to use for the team for those who can not afford a set themselves. The CCGA will be sending out a community wide e-mail with more information in the next week. At that time, Greg then asked the members for a motion to increase the CCGA's annual donation to the high school from \$250 to \$300. The motion was made, no discussions followed. The motion was accepted unanimously. It is the CCGA's plan to invite Coach Goings and some of the team to next months meeting to accept the donation and whatever clubs are collected from the community.

Andrew reported that he and Dean Woods have been compiling information with regard to the 2009 Carolina's Inter Club Match Play Tournament. Initial registration with the CGA will be March 6th. The entry (with a \$300 check) must be made by April 1st. Play is scheduled to begin in May. The finals (final four, both semi-final and final matches) will be played on November 7th/8th at Pine Needles Lodge and GC, Southern Pines, NC. Andrew plans to have entry forms ready by in approximately two weeks and will be available from either Andrew or Dean and also in the Pro Shop.

February 17, 2009

Greg Pasco called the meeting to order and welcomed all those present. Greg introduced Coach Jason Goings and six members of the Silver Bluff High School Golf Team and presented them with a check from the CCGA in the amount of \$300. Coach Goings then thanked the members for the generous contribution and for organizing the collection of golf equipment from throughout the community. They were able to completely outfit four team members and the remainder of the equipment will be used during PE classes to introduce the game of golf to other young men and women.

At this time, Dan Mulvey introduced Sean Daly of South Aiken Physical Therapy who was our guest speaker for the evening. Sean, who was born, raised and educated in Australia, demonstrated a number of proactive flexibility and stabilization tests, exercises and stretches that would improve our golf games. Members found the program not only informative but also amusing as "volunteers" tested their flexibility and stabilization (or lack of). 
8. NEW BUSINESS



4. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE – Steve Santos & Mike Lesick

Mike reported that 40 players participated in the June Two- person Captains Choice event. The next CCGA event will be August 8th; the format is still to be determined.

Greg reminded members that the Club will be holding a July Fourth Tournament and cook –out. More information is available in the Pro shop

5. HANDICAP/RULES COMMITTEE – George Montgomery/Mickey Collins

Mickey announced that the committee has finished compiling the black tee information and some of the results were very interesting. The committee will be publishing the results soon. After the committee meets with Laurie regarding a local rules discussion, corrected score cards will be developed for the new season.

6. CLUB REPORT –Laurie

Laurie announced that the club will be working on better maintenance plans. The greens recently had small tine aeration. Unfortunately there was a malfunction on green #1 and the recent rains washed away the top dressing on some of the others that had to be re-sanded. There is a thatch layer that prevents healthy grass growth on the greens. They were going to re- pencil tine this week but chose to wait until next week. Laurie was asked by several members if it would be possible to roll the greens prior to the Inter Club matches this week end? Laurie stated that she would look into it.

In an effort to increase participation in the Club Championship Tournament, the Club has created a survey (located in the Pro shop) that they would like members to participate in.

The Family Tee Program markers are now on the course. Eventually special score cards will be available. Families are invited to enjoy a day of golf.

determined if there will be a Dogfight that day. Once the Club has a confirmed number of ladies they will make a decision on the Dogfight.

The Club will be hosting the July 4th Red, White and Blue Tournament on (of course) July 4th. This will be a 2 person Better Ball format with a 9 AM shot gun start to be followed by a cook out. Participants are reminded to wear red, white and blue.

Happy Hour at the Grille will be from 4:30 to 6:30 on June 24th. Everyone is welcome.

Laurie thanked all the volunteers who helped out with this year's Hook a Kid on Golf. Thirty five kids participated here at Cedar Creek.

7. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

8. NEW BUSINESS

With reference to the letter included with the GC@CC statement received by club members and the letter sent via e-mail to CCGA members on June 10th, Greg opened a discussion regarding the future direction of the CCGA. Greg explained that before the Board makes a decision (if any) it would like to hear member's opinions on what they see as the future roll of this organization. Greg asked that this be a polite and orderly discussion, and for the most part, it was. Below is the condensed version of the discussion.

Jim Mitchell: The Advisory Group and the CCGA are two diverse entities. The CCGA should continue in its current capacity.

Ron Phillips: Is there a current Advisory Board, has it met and who appointed its members?

Bill Ely: Hold off any decisions until the Advisory Group is proven to work.

Calvin Bennett: Who is the Advisory Group and who appointed them?

Question deferred to Laurie. She met with the CCGA and identified nine groups to be represented by the advisory board. Those groups include Wed. & Fri. Residents, Ladies 18, Ladies 9, Chihuahuas, Friday night Scramble Walkers and the CCGA.

Bill Hunkele: What happens to this Advisory Group if Laurie leaves the CG@CC?

Pat Sullivan: the things the CCGA does cost money. If these things are taken over will we be paying dues to the Advisory Group? Personally, I feel if it ain't broke . . .

Greg reminded members that the dues collected annually and any money made from its tournaments are used to fund the Memorial Garden and Remembrance ceremony, is used to ensure that any member making a hole-in-one receives at least \$100 and a recognition trophy, is used to update or create recognition plaques, is used to correct any errors from the dogfight, supports a number of charities and most importantly we support the Silver Bluff High School Golf team with a monetary contribution as well as what ever else the ask us to help with.

The Handicap and Rules Committee is not a CCGA committee. Since it impacts all play at the club, it is a part of the Advisory Group.

It may have been easier to incorporate an advisory board into the CCGA as it is the only group that has members from across most, if not all of the nine groups. The CCGA may very well stifle the Advisory Group.

Calvin Bennett: Again who appointed the members of this Advisory Group?

Greg: Laurie appointed the members to the Advisory Group

Marty Katz : The CCGA Constitution and By Laws states that the purpose of the CCGA is "to promote fellowship and welfare among members of the Golf Club at Cedar Creek, and to foster a desire for advancement and improvement of their golf game." Any decision must be voted on but a quorum of members need to eliminate this controversy between the CCGA and the Club map out on paper what can and can't be done by each group then come to an agreement.

Ron Phillips: Why are we just now hearing about this?

Greg and Sue: It has been on the agendas and in the minutes for several months.

Greg stated that if a decision is to be made regarding the future of the CCGA it should be done before the beginning of the new fiscal year in October.

Jan Barker: The CCGA does not promote fellowship for all members. There is a perception of the CCGA = the Dogfight.

John Turner (directed to Laurie): Why establish the Advisory Group at all?

Laurie: to pull all the various groups under one group for consistency.

Doug Boyers: Shouldn't the various groups be weighted, CCGA being largest should have more representation than the smallest group(s)?

Ron Phillips: Who will finance the dogfight, hole-in-one, etc without the CCGA? What happens to the Advisory Group if the Pro leaves the Club? Let the CCGA worry about the groups and let the Club worry about the course.

Mickey Finn: How many members belong to the GC@CC? (approx. 300) How many members of CCGA? (173) Then the CCGA represents more than 50% of the club membership. Are we (the CCGA) being moved out?

Calvin Bennett: The (CCGA) By-Laws mean nothing – final decisions are made by Hank and Carol.

Mimi Wittkamp: I am not aware of any perceptions; it appears that the CCGA is the voice for a majority of the golfers here.

Paul Pecorarro: Is there a financial drive here?

Greg: not that we are aware of

Laurie: we want to run this like a club, with consistency

Paul: will the Club make money on the tournaments?

Earl Bennett: How many tournaments will the club have?

Laurie: one a month probably

Jim Mitchell: I am not aware of any meetings or feed back from six of the seven groups.

Greg to Jan Barker: Have the Ladies had discussions regarding the Advisory Group?

Jan: yes, they have had discussions.

Jan Barker: With reference to "if it ain't broke . . ." something's broke. This is the largest meeting you've had in my experience.

(This is where it became somewhat unruly. Too many people speaking at once to keep track of what was said)

Steve Santos: No matter what we do (CCGA Tournament Committee) women will not participate. The club fights all CCGA activities. Steve went on to give examples.

Marty Katz: At one time CCGA had over 100 participants in its tournaments. The CCGA is not now nor has it ever been gender specific. I believe the low participation is a sign of hard economic times, an aging membership and food issues with the Grille. My perception is that we all can't work together.

Tom Burcroff: As was stated, the CCGA is the biggest voice of the members

Mimi Wittkamp: Has the CCGA considered having a tournament with no winners, a tournament just for the fun of playing?

Burt Wronsky: I have heard rumors that the club wants to take over the Dogfight. Would we still receive cash prizes?

Laurie: It's possible

Greg: The CCGA has no intention of letting go of the Dogfight. We (the CCGA Board) will not be putting this organization to bed any time soon. This organization may have run its course in its current role and now we are looking at its future direction.

Burt Wronsky: I would ask the CCGA Board to request from the ownership, those things that will change (regarding membership) next year prior to our making a commitment on October 1st.

Greg: The Board will do what it can.

Paul Pecoraro: Are you looking for a motion tonight?

Greg: No, again we (the CCGA Board) would like to make a decision on the direction if this organization prior to the beginning of the new season.

Dan Mulvey: Laurie, what's the vision? Where is the Club going with this?
Laurie: to provide tournaments, improve course conditions, and provide the social things that happen.


Earl Bennett: The Club may want to meet with the general population of its members.

It was planned and anticipated at the beginning of our fiscal year, to set aside approx. \$200 from the T Box Sponsorship prize funds, to be used for a year end cash drawing for CCGA participants in our tournaments.
