Spring is here and with favorable temps following earlier application of herbicide and fertilizer the course will soon be turning green again. The greens are in good condition having held their color through the winter. Greens are being mowed and mowing elsewhere as needed is underway soon to be more frequent. Gary and his staff have done a good deal of work clearing undergrowth and brush from areas outside of the roughs giving the course a "clean" look (and not so incidentally making it easier to locate a wayward ball).

Feel good – play the Creek!

A reminderit is a breach of etiquette to pull the ball from the hole using the head of your putter due to the likelihood that you will damage the hole thus making it difficult for those who follow to putt not to mention very annoying. It's a practice that is plainly bad for the cups and greens. The only exception, as it were, is if you may have a suction cup or four-prong attachment on your putter grip that will lift the ball cleanly from the hole without damaging the edges of the cups.

Also, now that the pin may be left in the hole when putting, retrieval of your ball with the pin in the hole may also damage the cup. A better practice is to gently remove the pin and then retrieve your ball. This will reduce the "doughnut" effect around the hole and keep the edges of the cups much sharper.
