These include President, Vice President, Treasurer, Tournament Committee Chairman and various Tournament Directors. GACC has been a successful developing organization for the past three years, but it is always in the best interest of the membership to bring in new blood and new ideas. Don provided an update on the Sponsors Tournament to be held August 17. We have 11 sponsors signed up to play, and he is continuing to fill sponsor and guest pairings with two GACC members.

George reported that we have 207 members as of this date, about the same level of participation as last year.

It was noted that if GACC ceases to exist, our Constitution mandates that any money left in the Treasury will be given to the Cedar Creek Golf Course with no stipulations. A motion was made and seconded that, if GACC is forced to disband due to lack of membership interest, the monies in the GACC treasury will be used to fund the “End-of-Year” party. The motion was unanimously approved by all attendees.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:40 PM.
