

MINUTES OF JUNE 19, 2024 BOARD MEETING

The meeting was called to order by David at 4:04 PM. The minutes of the June 5, 2024, meeting were approved as written.

Don provided an update on the upcoming July 4th Tournament:

- We have 60+ players signed up so the Pub will serve lunch as in past tournaments. Kim reported that the menu will include typical picnic cookout food such as hamburgers, hot dogs, potato salad, cole slaw, baked beans & apple pie. Kim will explore drink specials with the Pub staff.
- Payouts were discussed and approved.
- The “flag” portion of the event was also discussed. Any player who finishes their round with strokes to spare (having a gross score ***less than*** 72 plus their handicap) will receive a flag with their name on it and use their remaining strokes to play Hole #1. Their flag will be planted in the spot where the ball comes to rest after the last stroke. The flag closest to the pin will denote the winner. If no players qualify, there is no winner and no payout will be made.
- Players will be encouraged to wear red, white & blue golf attire to commemorate the July 4th Holiday. Alan will include this in a tournament reminder email blast to be sent out to all GACC members.

George provided attendees with a first look at the flyer for the Gary’s Revenge tournament, a 4-person scramble to be held on August 3. The flyer looked good with no comments; however, how to effectively describe the peculiarities of each hole to all participants was discussed. Consistent with last year’s event, a handout will be provided on each cart for players to reference before playing each hole.

Miscellaneous items considered by attendees were as follows:

- Any decision on holding our next “ALL HANDS’ update meeting was postponed until the reported sale of the Golf Course becomes more definitive.
- Extra photographs taken by others and a seemingly high number of volunteers were both felt to be unique to the Bling tournament. Nevertheless, volunteer involvement will be monitored by Tournament Directors going forward and, if additional photographs over and above those taken by the “official” GACC photographer Judy Nightingale are submitted, Dave King will be consulted so that they are provided to him in an acceptable format for posting on the website.
- Laurel Oates stopped by and said she had many suggestions for improving the Shootout next year. Don will get her list and disseminate it to the Board for future action.

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Don provided an update on the Sponsors Tournament tentatively scheduled for August 17th. Out of 27 sponsors, we have only received 6 yeses plus one who would like to attend any post-golf meal. Since a cutoff date of July 1st was included in our letter to them, any decision regarding this event will be tabled until our next Board meeting scheduled for July 2nd.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:13 PM.
